# Youth leader unity

How to catalyse and sustain it  
in every city and town – together.



## Considerations

1. Why is youth leader unity in each location important?
2. What common pitfalls might hinder a measurable result from this area of unity?
3. What might catalyse active unity where it doesn't exist and/or help to sustain it?

### 1. Promotion by all

- As we perceive the benefits of localized youth leader unity we all promote it – which generates it.

### 2. A 'how to guide' to support

### 3. Annual vision casting via an email to a key youth leader in every city and town

- Pending the national youth outreach survey which can establish a network, this possibility was noted. This could
  - (a) check the person is still the contact for local youth leaders
  - (b) offer the 'lead and feed fund' (suggestion #5)
  - (c) encourage the vision of 'unity for outreach' (unity – equipping - schools - events)
  - (d) passing on both the unity and school groups 'how to' guides.
- Envisaged result:
  - Youth leaders empowered with a higher level of vision for their united mission
  - A national network established which any pioneering a national youth cause can benefit from,

### 4. A website representing this group to be created – including a map of youth unity facilitators

- christianyouthunity.nz will be the URL

### 5. A 'Lead and Feed Fund'

- Purposed to help catalyse youth leader unity – and consistency in it. \$8 per attendee per meeting. Administered and currently underwritten by the SLT, this is to be accessed via christianyouthunity.nz so it represents us all.
- The condition: Gatherings are in a private location – not a café (church lounge / someone's home). This enables private space – envisioning – prayer – more meaningful connection.
